To vote in the 2025 municipal election, voters must be named on the permanent electors register, and produce one piece of identification issued by a Canadian government, whether federal, provincial or local, or an agency of that government, that contains a photograph of the person. The following types of verification meet the standard provincial requirement for one piece of identification.

- Alberta Drivers License
- Alberta Identification Card
- Certificate of Indian Status Card
- First Nation Membership Card
- Métis Nation of Alberta Citizenship Card
- Métis Settlement Membership Card
- Firearm Possession and Acquisition (PAL) License
- Alberta Service Dog ID card
- Canadian Passport
- Canadian Citizenship Card
- CANPASS, FAST, or Nexus Card
- CATSA Identification Card
- Canadian Forces ID Card
- Veterans Health Care ID Card

All non-registered voters are required to:

- Complete a statement of elector eligibility that they are eligible to vote.
- Show valid government issued identification containing the voters photograph, name, and current address.
