B) The Municipal Manager provided a synopsis of the discussion at the Redcliff Planning Board meeting in regard to Subdivision Application 2011 SUB 03, specifically the status of the closed lane. It was the consensus of the Board to determine if Council has an interest in re-opening the lane at the rear of the proposed lots, prior to further consideration of the subdivision application and recommendations to Council. The Municipal Manager advised that during the subdivision process the Town has an opportunity to legally reclaim the closed lane without compensation to the land owner. Discussion ensued with regard to a previous subdivision which created lots utilizing a portion of the closed lane to ensure that the lot sizes met the Town of Redcliff Land Use Bylaw. If Council decides to reopen and develop the lane then the Town would have to negotiate with the land owners to reclaim the closed lane included in the previous subdivision to reopen the lane.

B. Stigter and J. Mayberry were in attendance and advised that they had no objection to the reopening of the lane. D. Kilpatrick expressed support for reopening the lane and suggested that there may be an opportunity to do a land exchange for the portion of the lane that would be reclaimed and the portion of the existing lane that would no longer be required; however this would involve a further lane closure. Discussion ensued with regard to delaying the subdivision application process however B. Stigter and J. Mayberry had no objection to a delay at this time as the land swap could in effect give them enough property to ensure that the lots being created would meet the required lot size in the current Land Use Bylaw. Brief discussion ensued.

It was the unanimous Consensus of Council to proceed with the reopening and development of the lane and negotiations thereof.
