BACKGROUND:

At the August 18, 2014 council meeting the following motion was made:

"Councillor Leipert moved to table the request for Decision regarding MPE's Request for Engineering Budget Increase to the September 8th, 2014 meeting of Council in order to obtain additional information and clarification on project costs/grant funding"

The total budget for the Water Treatment Plant (including Distribution Pump and Irrigation Supply), Raw Water Pump Station, and Raw Water Pipeline is **\$20,250,333**. Total actual cost is estimated to be at \$20,099,360, *plus* miscellaneous addition cost that was not included in the original budget in the amount of \$161,969, *plus* the proposed increase in fees from MPE in the amount of \$94,600, bringing the total cost to **\$20,355,929**, or approximately **\$105,596** over the original budget.

The Town has applied for funding from Alberta Transportation in 2007 based on Stantec's cost estimates for Water Treatment Plant upgrade through AMWWP (Alberta Municipal Water and Wastewater Program) grant and received an approval in April 2011 with amount of \$5,525,482.00 based on 44.62% cost share. During the preparation of pre-design report from MPE in 2012 some scope changes were required and added to the design which includes major upgrade in Pump Station and pipeline twinning and other changes. The Town is in process of discussion with Alberta Transportation for the confirmation of acceptable additional costs and a new application will be required to get the ministerial approval for additional costs as per the new policy from Alberta Transportation on currently approved projects.

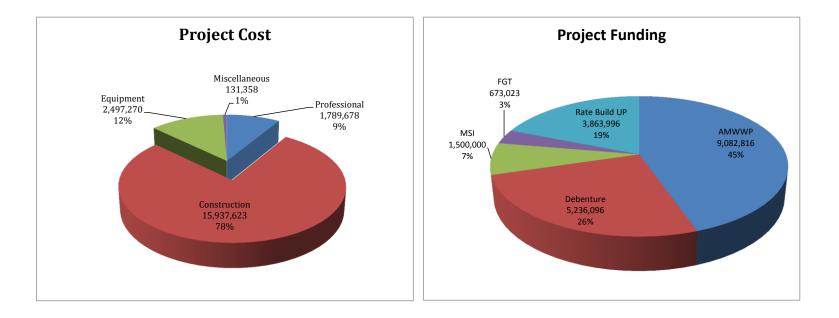

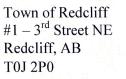

RE: Water Treatment Plant Request for Engineering Budget Increase

As detailed design and tendering of the project has been completed, and with the impending start of construction, we have reviewed the scope of work included in the project relative to the scope defined in the Pre-design Report. Engineering fee budgets were established for this project by utilizing the work scope defined in the Pre-Design Report. As the work scope has increased since completion of the report, MPE respectfully requests an increase to the approved engineering budget, based upon the following breakdown:

Additional items added to the scope of work, and related estimated costs:

- Chlorine Gas Scrubber System: \$320,000
- Polymer Feed System: \$140,000
- Additional Distribution Connection and Pipeline to 9th Avenue: \$125,000
- Reject Water Increased Capacity for Supplementing Raw Water Supply: \$50,000
- Paving and Additional Site Access: \$175,000
- Locate Generator In WTP Building: \$50,000

Total estimated value of the added scope is \$860,000.00. Engineering fees for this project were established at 11%. Based upon this fee percentage, an additional budget of \$94,600.00 is respectfully requested. Based on your AMWWP funding level of 44.62%, the Town's portion of the increased fees would be \$52,389.48.

These additional fees are requested as budget was consumed during the design phase for these additional items. Consuming additional budget has in effect, taken budget from our construction management and construction administration fees. To ensure that budgetary concerns do not impact our service levels, this budget increase is being requested.

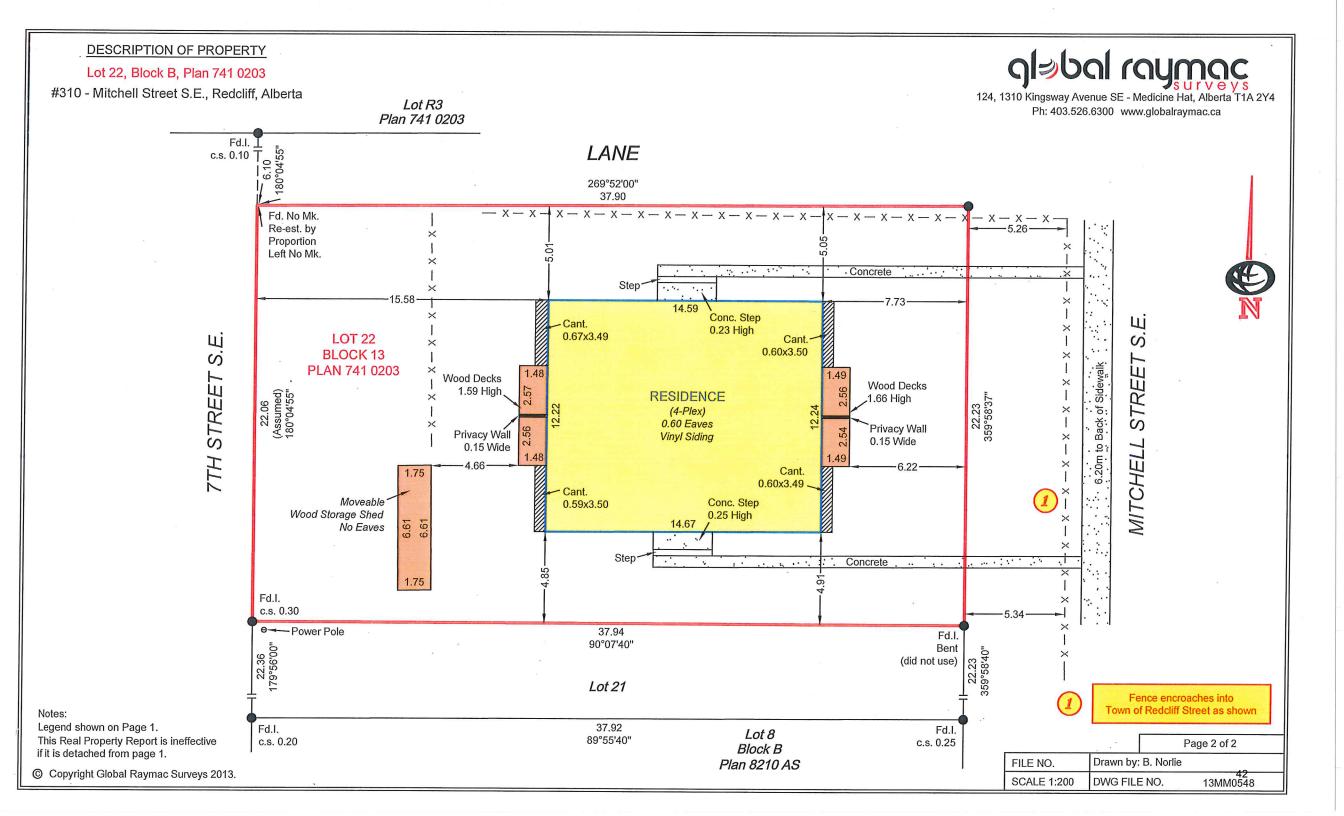

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TOWN OF REDCLIFF BYLAW NO. 1751/2013

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF REDCLIFF for the purposes of authorizing the issuance of Encroachment Permits.

WHEREAS, it is deemed expedient and proper for a Council to authorize the issuance of an Encroachment Permit.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDCLIFF, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

TITLE

1. This Bylaw shall be known as the **Encroachment Permit Bylaw**.

ENCROACHMENT PERMITS

- 2. Encroachment permits:
 - a) where the encroaching structure does not encroach more than .31 metres onto Town of Redcliff Property the request for an encroachment permit may be approved by the Municipal Manager and such approval shall be copied to Council for information only;
 - b) where the encroaching structure does encroach more than .31 metres onto Town of Redcliff Property the request for an encroachment permit shall be forwarded to Council for consideration.
- 3. The fee for an encroachment permit shall be in the amount of \$100.00 plus GST for each encroachment permit issued.
- 4. Prior to the issuance of an encroachment permit the Town of Redcliff will require the owner of an encroaching structure to make application for an encroachment permit on the standard form as shown on Schedule "A" attached to this Bylaw and provide a copy of a Real Property Report (RPR) prepared by an Alberta Land Surveyor, or other acceptable survey identifying the encroachment.
- 5. The information that will be required prior to processing an encroaching permit shall include:
 - a) indemnification of Town of Redcliff from any damage or liability associated with the encroaching structure;
 - b) indemnification of Town of Redcliff for any damages that may occur to the encroaching structure resulting from the need to maintain or construct in the area of the encroachment;
 - c) removal of the encroaching structure, at no cost to the Town of Redcliff, should in the opinion of the Town of Redcliff such structure has become dilapidated;
 - d) removal of the encroaching structure, at no cost to the Town of Redcliff, should the Town of Redcliff need access to the encroached upon area in the event of utility maintenance, new utility construction or road development.

My

- e) acknowledgement that the encroachment permit is terminable by Town of Redcliff upon issuance of 30 days notice in writing to the property owner at the last address as shown on the taxation records of the Town of Redcliff.
- 6. Encroachment permits may only be issued to the present owner of said encroaching structure;
- 7. Upon sale of the land the encroachment permit issued by the Town of Redcliff is terminated unless:
 - a) If the encroaching structure is sold to a different party the acquiring owner may apply for an encroachment permit to be issued providing the following conditions are met:
 - i) the terms and conditions on the encroachment permit to be issued are identical to the encroachment permit issued to the vendor;
 - ii) the request is made in writing and received by the Town of Redcliff within 60 days of the date of the original encroachment permit;
 - iii) the written request, includes a declaration confirming there have been no adjustments to any building on the site since the date of the issuance of the original encroachment permit.
 - iv) there will be no additional fee charged for issuance of this encroachment permit.
- 8. That effective upon passage of this Bylaw, The Council of the Town of Redcliff hereby authorizes the Municipal Manager, or his designate, to sign, on behalf of the Town of Redcliff, encroachment permits as shown on Appendix "A" attached.
- 9. Bylaw 1177/98 is hereby repealed

418(1) Each municipality must offer for sale at a public auction any parcel of land shown on its tax arrears list if the tax arrears are not paid.

(2) Unless subsection (4) applies, the public auction must be held in the period beginning on the date referred to in section 417(2)(a)and ending on March 31 of the year immediately following that date.

(3) Subsection (1) does not apply to a parcel in respect of which the municipality has started an action under section 411(2) to recover the tax arrears before the date of the public auction.

(4) The municipality may enter into an agreement with the owner of a parcel of land shown on its tax arrears list providing for the payment of the tax arrears over a period not exceeding 3 years, and in that event the parcel need not be offered for sale under subsection (1) until

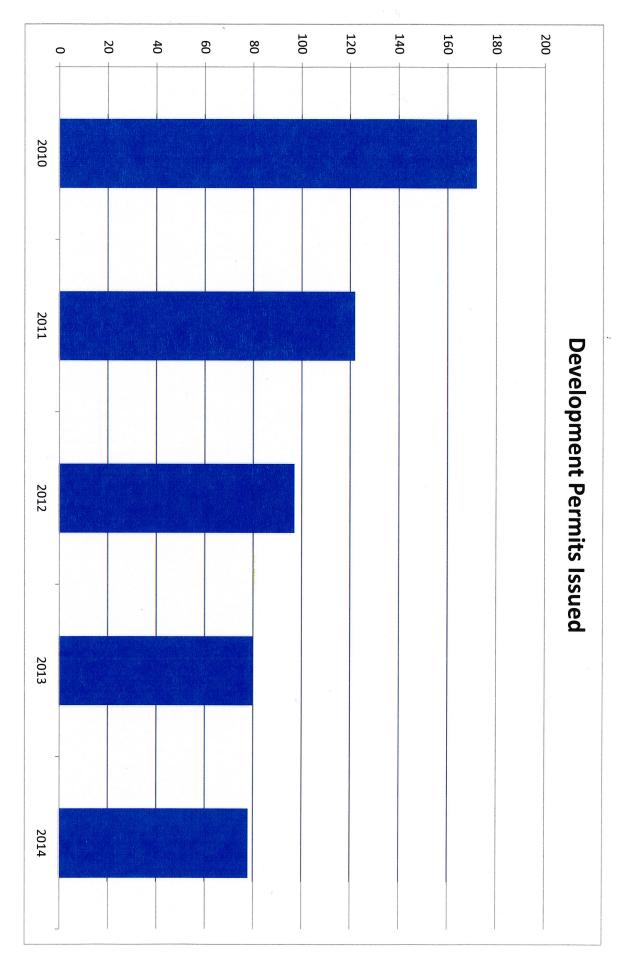

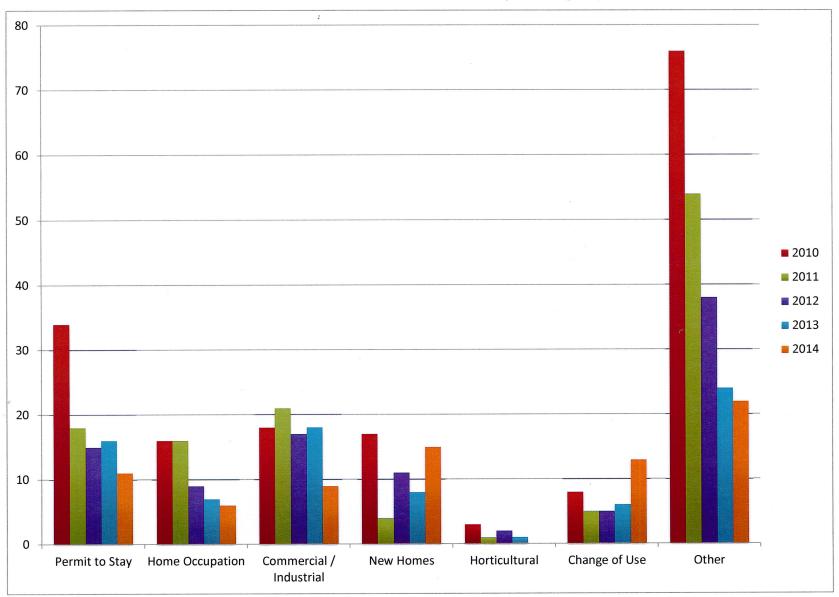

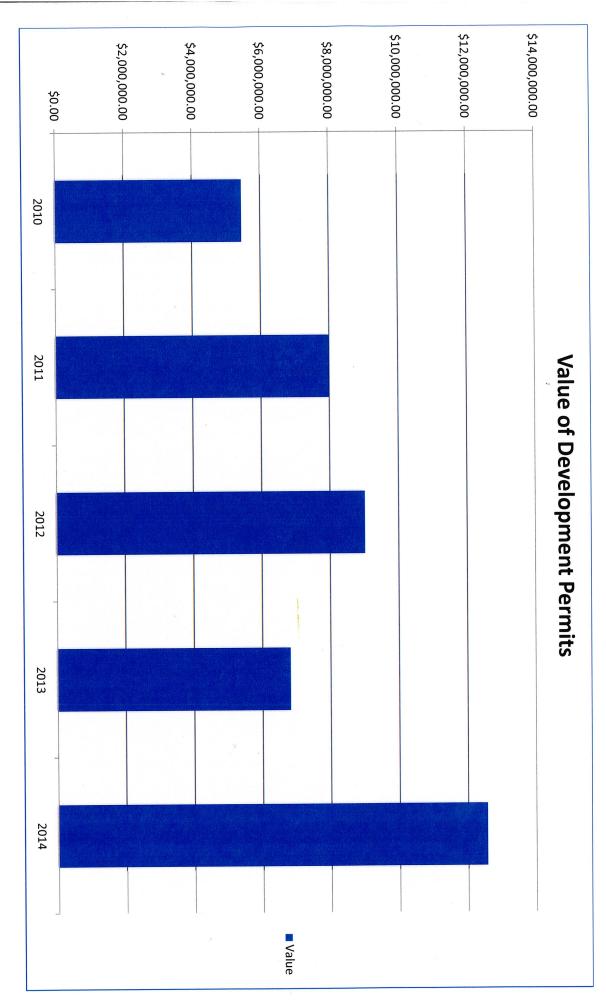
