Redcliff facilities are open, including the Rec-Tangle, campground, playgrounds, and baseball diamonds, but there is no cleaning or sanitization on play equipment, and **public washrooms** are open – with limited daily sanitizing. The public is reminded to carry hand sanitizer, wash frequently, maintain social distancing, and stay home if sick.
