Representatives from the Redcliff Youth Centre and Redcliff Action Society for Youth were in attendance to ask Town Council to consider a funding increase.

The following bylaw was given first, second, and third readings by Council:

- Bylaw 1920/2021, a bylaw to amend Bylaw 1358/2003 1st Avenue SW (600-700 Blocks) Storm Sewer Project Bylaw and Bylaw 1470/2006 being a bylaw to amend Bylaw 1358/2003
