Quentin Randall, Executive Director of Palliser Economic Partnership, was in attendance to present Palliser Economic Partnership's market entry and investment attraction plan to Council.

A public hearing was held regarding Bylaw 1923/2021, being an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw to add Shipping Containers as a Discretionary Use - Commission in the P-1 - Park and Recreation District. No comments or submissions were made.

The following bylaws were passed by Council:

- Bylaw 1922/2021, being an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw to add Shipping Containers as a Discretionary Use - Commission to the P-1 - Park and Recreation District
- Bylaw 1925/2021, 2021 Tax Rate Bylaw

The following bylaw was given first reading by Council:

- Bylaw 1926/2021, being an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw to add Accessory Building and Accessory Use as a Discretionary Use - Development Officer to the P-1 - Park and Recreation District and I-2 - Heavy Industrial District

Council requested that Administration create an online survey to gather public feedback regarding the Town's strategic planning goals for 2022-2026. A survey will be forthcoming and will be posted on the Town's website and social media channels and will be live for two weeks.

Administration was authorized to set up a temporary pop-up patio space in Legion Memorial Park once public health restriction ease and allow for patio dining. The Town will also advertise local establishments that provide takeout food and that can be enjoyed on the temporary patio.

Administration was also authorized to install a 3" water service line to the cemetery for the purpose of irrigating the site.
