A public hearing was held regarding Bylaw 1924/2021, being an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw to add Trade and Contractor Service as a Discretionary Use - Development Officer in the C-2 - Downtown Commercial District. No comments or submissions were made.

The following bylaw was passed by Council:

Council awarded the facility assessment study project to Associated Engineering for a total price of \$111,964.11. This project will provide the current state of fifteen Town-owned buildings. The Town will use this report for future capital planning for replacement of systems or entire buildings.

Council determined the location for the recycling depot site as 702 South Railway Drive SE. The project budget will be increased from \$50,000.00 to \$130,076.97. Administration will apply to amend the funding application under the Gas Tax Fund, and any shortfall not covered under the grant will be funded from the purchasing reserve. Council also requested that Administration conduct research on solar lighting options as a possible alternative lighting source at the site.

The following policies were considered by Council:

- Policy No. 030 - Redcliff Public Library Building Maintenance (policy cancelled, and a facility use agreement will be drawn up instead in consultation with the Town of Redcliff Library Board)
- Policy No. 035 - Sanitary Sewer Blockage (updated policy)
- Policy No. 047 - Insurance Claims (updated policy)
