The following bylaw received first reading:

- Bylaw 1928/2021, Temporary Emergency Storage Bylaw

A Special Event Application from the Redcliff Lions Club was approved for the Herman Wahl Memorial Cruise. The vehicle cruise will take place through town during Redcliff Days on August 28, 2021 beginning at 3:00 p.m.

An Encroachment Permit was authorized for 302 Main Street N (Lot 60, Block 138, Plan 9812329).

- Consolidation of Lot 21MR, Block 7, Plan 0212632 and Lot 20, Block 7, Plan 0212632; costs to be the responsibility of the purchaser.
- Partial discharge of utility right-of-way including any removal of any underground infrastructure is at the discretion of the purchaser; costs to be the responsibility of the purchaser.
