Constable Adam George of the RCMP was in attendance to present the Redcliff Detachment's Quarterly Policing Report and Multi-Year Financial Plan. Council authorized the Mayor to sign the Multi-Year Financial Plan on behalf of the Town.

Joel Sawatzky of Stantec was in attendance to present the Sanitary Sewer Master Plan Preliminary Review Report, detailing potential options for the future treatment of wastewater in the Town.

The following bylaw received first reading:

- Bylaw 1929/2021, Water Conservation and Restriction Bylaw

Council will request a meeting with the Honourable Ric McIver, Minister of Municipal Affairs, during the 2021 AUMA Convention, and will discuss the following items:

- A high school in Redcliff
- A dam/weir on the South Saskatchewan River to address water supply

Council moved to maintain the current assessment and property tax rates on roll number 0242900 for the 2021 tax year.

A 3" water service line to replace the 2" water service line at Lions Park will be installed to assist with water pressure at the splash park.

Unspent funds from the Asset Management Continuation project will be reallocated to purchase new FMW budget software.

Council authorized the Town to enter into an agreement with Encompass Benefits and HR Solutions Inc for the supply of employee benefits.
