Re: Water Conservation and Restriction

Drought response is a shared responsibility with the Province, the federal government, water providers, regional districts, municipalities and First Nations and its users. In response to Alberta annoucing that we are all currently in a stage 4 (Out of 5) in its Water Shortage Management Response Plan, the Town is reviewing its own Water Shortage Response Plan and its Water Conservation and Restrictions Bylaw. What this means is that as a current water licence holder we must all be prepared and work together. As a water consumer we please ask you to think about the following in your home and daily activites when it comes to water conservation:

- 1) Please review and understand how much water your home uses and identify ways to reduce your use of water. Some examples include;
  - Check your toilets and appliances for leaks and install water-saving shower heads or flow restrictors, even a small drip can waste 50 or more gallons of water a day.
  - Take baths, a partially filled tub uses less water than all but the shortest showers
  - Turn off the water while brushing your teeth or while shaving
  - Water your lawn only when needed, see the Water Conservation and Restrictions Bylaw for suggested watering times, deep soak your lawn, don't water the gutter
  - Plant drought-resistant trees and plants as well as zeroscaping options
  - Use a broom to clean driveway, sidewalk and steps

The Town of Redcliff has currently not implemented any water conservation or restrictions but it is likely we will be doing so in the near future. The Town of Redcliff will update you as we proceed into the warmer months, please stay informed by visiting our website and our social media channels.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation on this matter. We will continue to update our community as new information becomes available.
