### **LOCK IT OR LOSE IT**

During 2023, Redcliff RCMP responded to several thefts from motor vehicle complaints within the Town of Redcliff. Usually, these complaints occur after a victim discovers that their vehicle was entered the following day, valuables were taken, and no suspect was identified.

completely well there are usually more unreported victims. Redcliff RCMP, along with South Eastern Alberta Crime Watch and Redcliff Citizens on Patrol, have an awareness campaign that can help citizens take action to prevent this crime. It is called "Lock it or Lose it."

### Lock It or Lose It Tips

- Do not leave your keys in the vehicle or accessible
- · Ensure your doors are always locked
- · Park in well-lit areas or a garage
- · Never leave money, valuables or packages in plain sight. Put them in your trunk or remove them from your vehicle
- · Roll up your windows
- Don't leave personal information such as vehicle registration and proof of insurance in the glove box
- Don't leave your car running while unattended
- If you often park in the parking lot, be sure to park in a different spot each time
- Using anti-theft devices (steering wheel locks) and immobilizers, car alarms, and GPS tracking systems.
